



VAC Weekend In House Gatherings COVID protocols

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our VAC weekend In House Gathering.

As part of welcoming everyone into the building and caring for each other well, we ask that;

- any person experiencing any signs of illness including cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat, is asked to stay home.
- anyone who has travelled outside of Canada or have been exposed to a COVID-19 refrain from attending
- you avoid handshaking, hugging and other direct physical contact with any guests who are outside your cohort, as per BC guidelines – instead offer a smile or a wave.
- as an act of kindness to others, masks will be required upon entry but once you are seated, you are free to remove the masks
- you practice good respiratory and hand washing hygiene

We are limiting the attendance numbers for In house gatherings to 50 people. This number may be lowered in response to British Columbia's guidelines. As an act of caring for one another, here are some other important things to consider;

- We have implemented increase cleaning protocols and will have hand sanitizer available
- If you are part of a vulnerable population, please consider joining us online for our weekly worship experience
- Please consider others in the frequency in which you register for weekend services, we want as many as possible to attend during our weekend In House Gatherings
- At this time we will not be offering VAC Tots or VAC Kids Programs simply due to building restrictions however, activity packs will be available.

We are looking forward to being together and while it will look very different, we know that regardless of restrictions, our hope and faith will be increased and strengthened as we embrace the promise of Matt 18:20, “ For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them “.
